THE TOURNAMENT RULES

- To be eligible to participate in the tournament each entrant must have completed an entry form and paid the registration fee no later than **Friday**, **November 3**th **at 19.00hrs**
- Upon registration all boats will be issued a **A-4** laminated sheet with a **team TAG**, with listed tournament information.
- All boats must have a mobile device/camera capable of taking photographs with date and timestamp.
- When registering each team must list what device/ camera will be used on fishing day.
 Also at registration, each team must take a picture with the same device of their captain holding the issued TAG, so officials can confirm date and time stamps are correct.
- To ensure all fish are caught on the competition day, and within the timeframe allotted for the tournament when a wahoo or multiple fish are caught, a photo with the fish and the designated TAG is to be taken.
- Pictures taken before or after the allotted date and time frame will not be counted.
- When you or your team arrives at the weigh station, you must provide judges with mobile device/camera photo proof of your catch.
- The angler must set the hook and bring the fish to gaff unaided: However, assistance in moving the rod from the Gunnel holder to the fighting chair is permitted.
- Harnesses may be used, and may be replaced or adjusted by another person.
- One or more gaffers are permitted to boat a fish.
- Once the catch is weighed by officials, all tails of fish brought to the weigh station will be cut.
- The heaviest wahoo of the event will be gutted with judges in attendance.
- All boats must be in Port (waterways of the Dock Maarten) by 16:30hrs on the fishing day, failure of doing so will result in disqualification from the competition.
 Upon arrival, you must seek radio contact with the SSFF committee, on VHF channel 06. (Judge(s) will be present with stop-watch and camera)
- The location of the weigh station will be close to the event stage.
- Protest must be filed in writing within 30 minutes after weigh-in time and will be entertained by the committee after receipt of payment of \$ 50,- and a case of cold COORS LIGHT. The payment of \$ 50 is nonrefundable.
- The committee has the right to inspect any participating boats and gear at any time.
- ALL BILLFISH MUST BE RELEASED, FISHERMEN THAT BRING BILLFISH BACK TO THE DOCKS, WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THIS TOURNAMENT.
- The official tournament Headquarters + Weigh Station will be appointed during skippers briefing.
- All boats must be at the designated declared point of departure on the Island of St.
 Maarten, unless requesting special written permission by the committee minimum 48hrs in advance of the tournament. (see contact info)
- Fishing of FAD's is prohibited. (pictures of vessel doing such are required)

THE TOURNAMENT RULES (continued)

- The entrant of the boat or someone so delegated will be responsible to ensure that these rules are enforced under pain of disqualification from the tournament.
- It shall be the responsibility of the Tournament Committee to adjudicate the written rules and to make necessary decisions where the situation has not been anticipated by the written rules. The Decision of the Judges committee is Final.
- All fish caught will be weighed and recorded on arrival at the designated Weighing-in-Station by an appointed Judge of Scales and duly witnessed by the entrant or his delegate.
- Any boat in distress must fly a Red Flag.
- All boats must have all standard safety equipment, also must have a VHF radio and standby and monitor channel 16.

EQUIPMENT

- No lines exceeding 80 lbs are permitted. (Monofilament or Braided)
- Wire (Monel) lines are permitted.
- Power driven reels are not permitted.
- Ratchet handle reels are not permitted.
- Reels designed for cranking with both hands are prohibited.
- Hand lines are not permitted.
- Not more than two hooks are permitted, per line.
- Live bait is permitted.
- Gang hooks are permitted only on plugs and artificial lures.
- Artificial and any other baits are permitted.
- Rosary (Rosario) is not permitted.
- Buoy (commercial) fishing is not permitted.
- Harpooning, lancing or shooting to assist in boating of fish is not permitted.

DISQUALIFICATION ACT

- Failure to comply with above listed rules and other regulations.
- Pictures taken before or after the allotted date and time frame will not be counted.
- Failure to provide pictures to judges of each fish landed, will result in disqualification of the catch. (example 4 pictures, yet 6 fish...only 4 fish will count)
- Boats not within the Dock Maarten waterways at cut off times, will result in disqualification of their catch of that day. (judges will be monitoring this closely)
- Jigging & Drift Fishing is prohibited.
- Fishing of FAD's is prohibited. (pictures of vessel doing such are required)
- Mutilation of fish caused by propellers, attacks of other fish, shooting and harpooning.
- No Wahoo under 20lbs, or other mentioned sport fish under 10lbs will be recognized.
- Any and all billfish killed during participation in this event.
- Spear guns, guns, missiles, dynamite or any type of commercial fishing gear such as long lines, nets, spotter planes or mother ships is prohibited.
